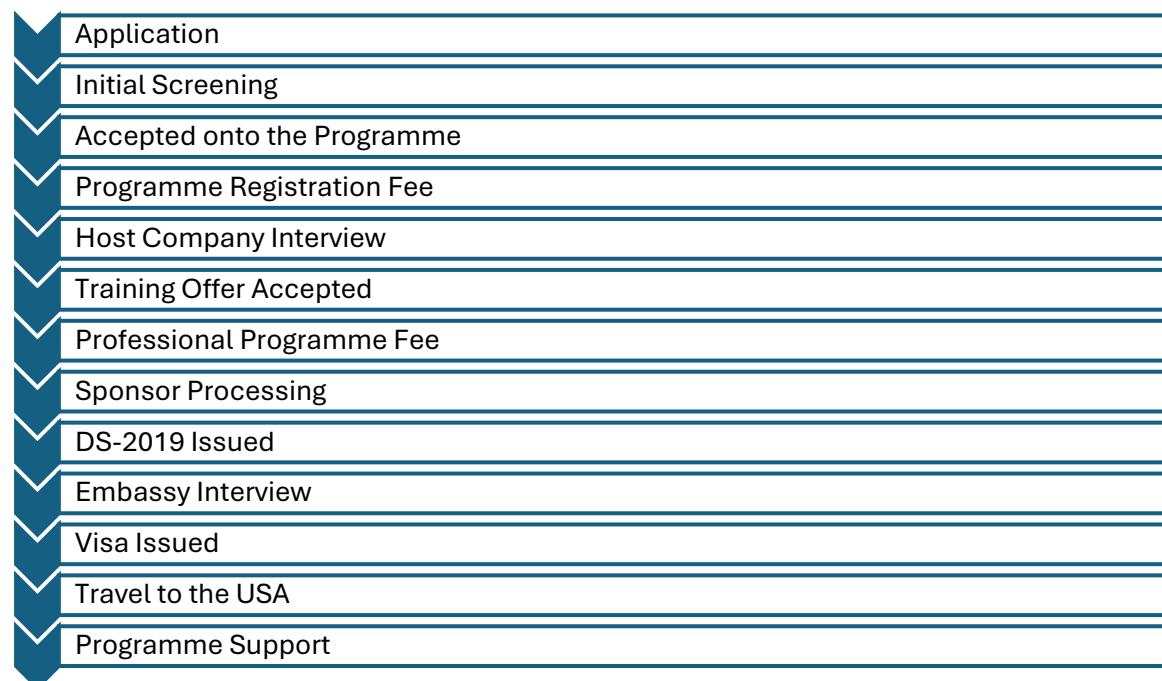

Administrative Payment Saving

The standard Programme Fee is USD \$4,250. Candidates who choose to pay by Wise or bank transfer are eligible for a USD \$255 administrative payment saving, reducing the total Programme Fee to USD \$3,995.

*The SEVIS Fee is collected by the Designated Sponsor and includes the applicable government fee together with any applicable sponsor administration fee.

Additional fees may apply where required by the Designated Sponsor, including:

- **DS-2019 Reissuance Fee (currently USD \$250)** where a replacement sponsorship document is required due to changes in the Candidate's circumstances, visa appointment delays, document expiry, or other circumstances requiring reissuance
- **Replacement Host Company Fee (currently USD \$750)**, where charged by the Designated Sponsor, if a replacement Host Company is required.

Government and sponsor-related fees are determined by the relevant government authority and/or Designated Sponsor and may change from time to time.

Candidates will be advised of the applicable fees before payment is required.

- Government and sponsor-related fees are payable separately unless otherwise stated.

Payment Methods

Training 4 Hospitality accepts payment by Visa, Mastercard and other major payment methods, as well as bank transfer and Wise.

For international payments, we recommend Wise or bank transfer, where available, as these methods can help reduce payment processing and currency conversion costs.

Administrative Payment Saving: Candidates who choose to pay by Wise or bank transfer are eligible for a USD \$255 administrative payment saving, reducing the total Programme Fee from USD \$4,250 to USD \$3,995.

Candidates are responsible for any bank charges or currency conversion fees applied by their own bank or payment provider.

If you experience any difficulties making payment, please contact Training 4 Hospitality and we will be happy to discuss the available payment options.

Frequently Asked Questions

When do I pay the Programme Registration Fee?

Only after you have successfully completed our screening process and have been accepted onto the Programme.

When do I pay the Professional Programme Fee?

Only after you have accepted a Host Company Training Offer.

Can I choose my Host Company?

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We will always consider your preferences; however, placements remain subject to Host Company recruitment requirements, Programme suitability and Designated Sponsor approval.

Can I request a particular location?

Candidates are welcome to express preferences, but placements cannot be guaranteed in a specific city, state or hotel brand.

Is accommodation included?

Accommodation arrangements vary between Host Companies.

Where accommodation is provided, details will be confirmed before Programme commencement.

Where accommodation is not included, guidance may be available through the Host Company or Programme Partner.

Are government fees included?

No.

Government and sponsor-related fees, including the SEVIS Fee and U.S. Embassy Visa Application Fee, are payable separately unless otherwise stated.

Do you offer a Direct Placement Programme?

Yes.

Candidates who have independently secured an eligible Host Company may be eligible for our Direct Placement Programme, subject to Designated Sponsor approval.

What happens if my visa application is refused?

Please refer to the Cancellation & Refund Policy within the Training 4 Hospitality Terms & Conditions for full details.

Do you offer a USA Seasonal Programme?

Yes.
